

VoIP Loudspeaker Zone Paging

Enhanced Network Audio Port (VIP-801) is used when a new paging system needs to be installed or an existing paging system needs to be expanded or extended. It provides line level audio output and control contact closure when paging.

Enhanced Network Station Port (VIP-811) is used with single line phones to receive calls from two-way intercom stations and handsets. It can dial any VoIP paging point(s) in the network for All Call or specific group or zone loudspeaker paging.

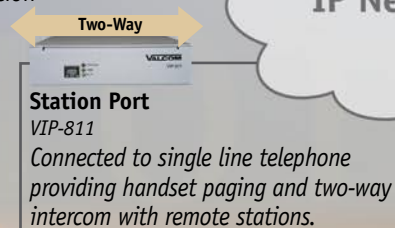
Central Security Paging/Intercom Control Station

Voice Paging Operation:

- Dial All Call to page everyone, or dial code to page specific building
- When you hear 3 beeps, begin speaking
- Terminate page by hanging up phone

Intercom Operation:

- Phone rings announcing incoming call
- Lift handset, communicate with remote location
