Enhanced Network Station Port (VIP-811) is used with single line telephone to provide call in intercom, handset communications and paging control.

Enhanced Network Audio Port (VIP-801) is used to interface to Valcom self-amplified paging loudspeakers. IP DoorPhone/Intercom (VIP-172L, VIP-9890-CB) is used to provide call-in with door/gate relay control.

Central Security Telephone


